*The order of play will be determined by a pre-draw conducted with a WUSPBA rep. Times will be posted on the website a week prior to the competition.

*Bands may play for critique; however there will be no prize or travel money available.

BY SUBMITTING THIS APPLICATION, YOU ARE AGREEING TO PSFA REQUIREMENTS AND PROCEDURES:

-There will be designated LOAD/UNLOAD area for pipe bands members at the corner of 200 South and Main Street. Please do NOT come in behind the Food Vendors. Only access the LOAD/UNLOAD are from Main Street. Once you have dropped off your equipment, parking for bands and soloists will be in the parking lot for the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saints or in the school parking lot.

-For Safety reasons, PLEASE HAVE ALL VEHICLES OUT OF THE PARK BY 7:30am SATURDAY. The police will be enforcing this. ALL sleep tents must be removed before 7:0am Saturday. ALCOHOL IS PROHIBITED from being sold or consumed in any manner during festival dates on park premises. DOGS and CATS must be kenneled. NO reptiles, birds, non-domesticated animals or other PETS allowed.

-There will be absolutely NO PARKING on Main Street in from on the park or along 200 South between Main Street and 100 East. This area is for food vendors and serves as an access to PSFA Board Members and City of Payson personnel involved with the festival as well as Ceilidh and Bandstand performers to load and unload. Any vehicle in this area must have a legitimate PSFA parking permit or it will be towed.
